Well done.

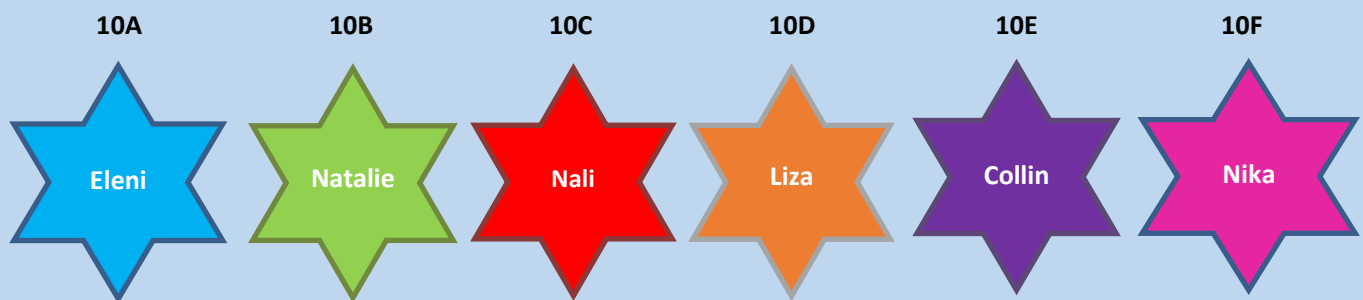
