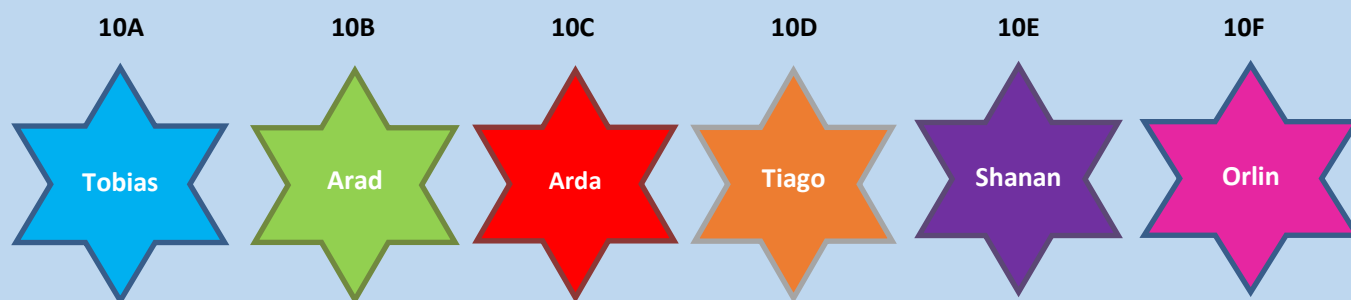
I wish all of Year 10 and their families a Happy Easter filled with rest and recuperation.
