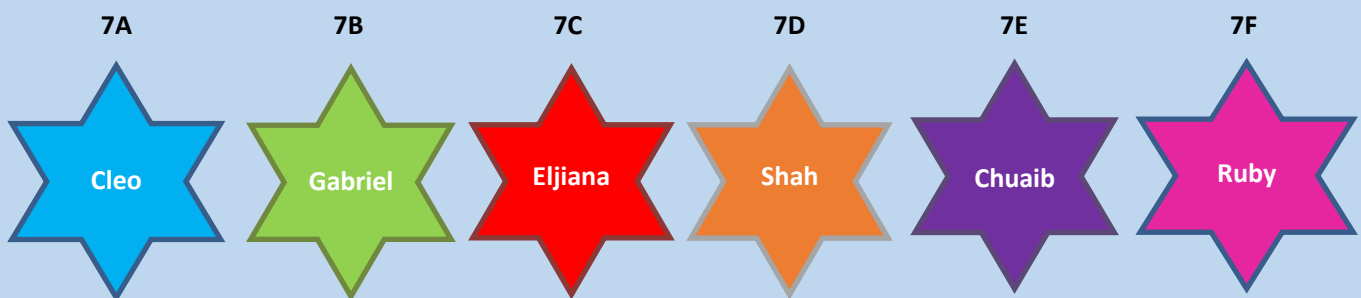

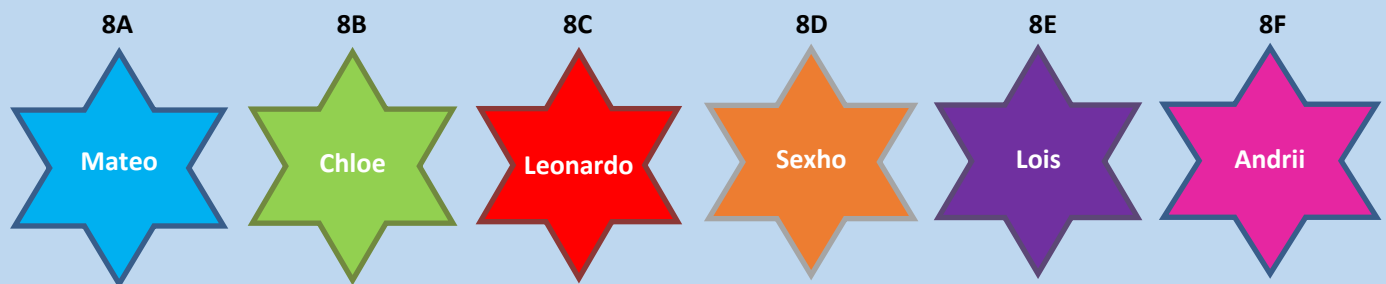

Well done Year 9, keep it up!

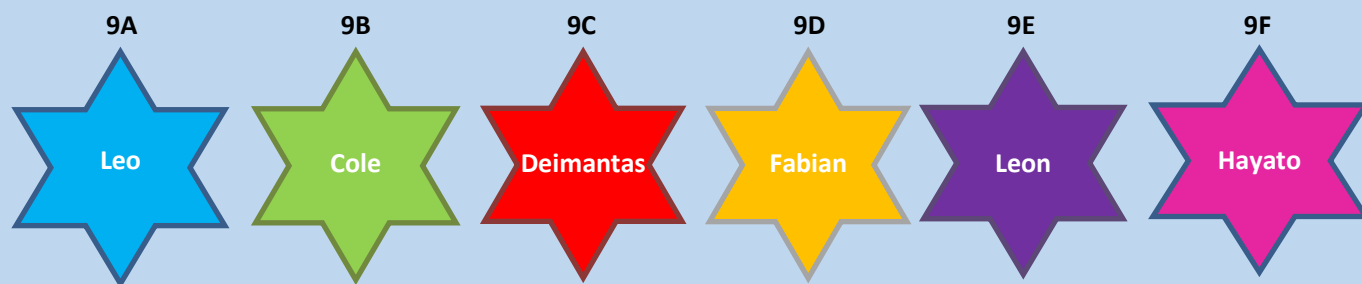
