



Friern Barnet School Destination Data

Schools are responsible for tracking post 16 students and to report on their chosen pathway.

The data is reported two years after the student has left Friern Barnet School i.e after they have completed VI form or College courses and successfully enrolled onto an undergraduate course, employment or training.
