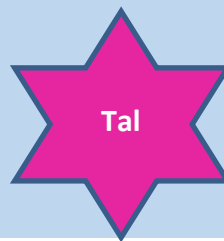

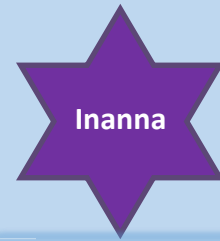

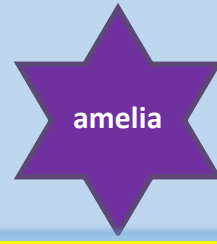

We look forward to welcoming students back on Thursday 3 September as they begin their full GCSE courses and take the next exciting step in their academic journey.

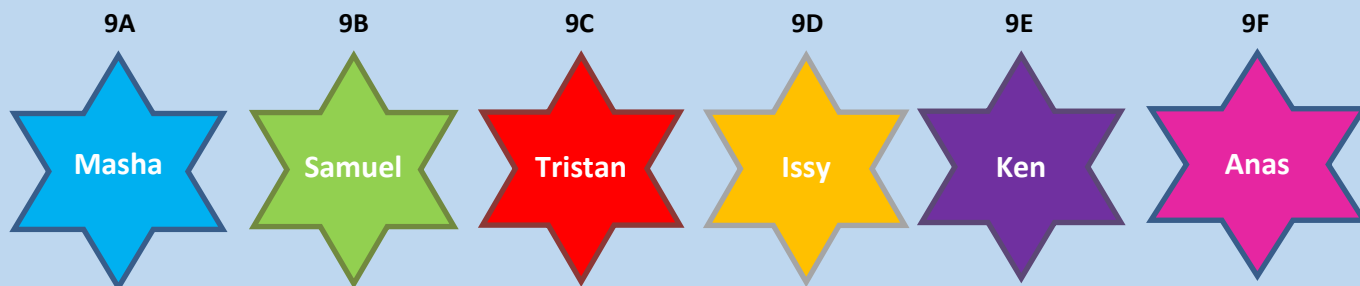
